TASTING NOTES

On the nose: bright orange and lemon zest, soft orange blossom, juniper, cucumber, and peppercorn. On the palate: orange petals come in first, followed by bright orange zest and cucumber on the mid-palate, with more blossom and petitgrain on exhalation.

WHAT'S IN IT

A total of 25 botanical ingredients. Fresh orange blossoms lead the way, supported by a variety of other California citrus fruit (Bergamot, Seville, and Valencia oranges, grapefruit, lemon, and lime). Angelica root, caraway, fresh cilantro, California bay laurel, cardamom, coriander, fresh cucumber, fresh dill, dill seed, fennel seed, fresh ginger, juniper, Malabar black pepper, nutmeg, orris root, pink peppercorn, Saigon cinnamon, and star anise complete the picture. The base is non-GMO grain neutral spirit.


THE EXPERIENCE
