VESPER

3 oz St. George Botanicore Gin
1 oz St. George All Purpose Vodka
½ oz Lillet Blanc

Stir all ingredients with ice to chill, then strain into a chilled cocktail glass. Garnish with a thin peel of lemon.



BEE'S KNEES

2 oz St. George Botanicore Gin
¾ oz honey syrup
¾ oz fresh lemon juice

Shake all ingredients with ice, then strain into a chilled coupe. Garnish with a lemon twist.
